

AIRPORT CHECK-IN STANDARDS

- Arrive at the airport at least **1 ½ - 2 hours prior to flight departure. Please have a government issued photo ID available at check-in (valid driver's license or passport)**
- You are allowed to carry-on one piece of luggage and check-in two pieces of luggage. Carry on luggage not to exceed 45 linear inches; Check in luggage not to exceed 62 linear inches in overall dimensions. Check luggage weight restriction is 50 pounds total. There is a 75.00 per bag charge if over the weight restriction.
- Your carry-on cannot contain razors or objects with an edge.
- Travelers may carry through security checkpoints **travel-size toiletries (3 ounces or less) that fit comfortably in ONE, QUART-SIZE, clear plastic, zip-top bag.**
- After clearing security, travelers can bring beverages and other items purchased in the secure boarding area on-board aircraft. **For more details you may log onto www.tsa.gov**
- **No meal service provided for flights less than 4 hours but there is snack service on board for purchase. You are allowed to bring snacks of your own onboard if you so wish.**
- **Checked luggage** will be inspected so it is advised **not to lock your luggage.** Also advised to carry extra film or batteries in your carry-on bag due to extreme sensitive X-ray machinery for checked luggage.
- There is a **service fee for Checked Bags** at the airport and this will vary with each airline. You can pay for your 1st and 2nd checked bags and save when you check in online. Fees range from 15.00 – 25.00 for the first piece of checked luggage and 25.00 – 35.00 for the 2nd.

Clothing

Comfortable, casual clothing and walking shoes are appropriate. While on tour, you may want to “dress up” for a special meal or theatre.

Packing tips

- Have identification with you and not in your checked luggage
- Leave valuables at homes
- Pack medication in your carry-on bag
- Select casual comfortable clothing and shoes
- Bring a hat, umbrella, Fall jacket/coat
- Bring extra film in your carry-on

Money: We recommend you plan for additional meals, snacks, beverages, gifts, Sightseeing while on tour. Major credit cards are accepted almost everywhere as are Visa gift cards, Visa check cards, Cash and Travelers checks. Not all venues will have an ATM machine readily available.

Gratuities: Customary gratuities for your local hosts and coach driver are on a voluntary basis and are usually given at the end of the tour. The suggested gratuity is \$2.00 –3.00 per person, per day.

Time Zone- always check the time zone you are traveling too.
